A NATIONAL PLATFORM TO STREAMLINE RARE CANCER MANAGEMENT

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Rare cancers account for 22% of all cancer diagnoses and 30% of all cancer deaths. Yet for most of these people, evidence-based management is not available. Consideration of the whole person diagnosed with a rare cancer, in addition to better understanding the molecular make-up of their tumour and predicting targeted forms of treatment, are all urgently required. A new national platform for patients with rare cancers, including a REDCap database, under the auspices of BioGrid Australia, is designed to streamline all aspects of rare cancer management and research.
